If your PikeRide+ lease is nearing 6 months, we will contact you to schedule the best time for us to perform maintenance. Make sure to relay any issues you may have had to us when we pick up the bike, to ensure it is addressed.

While we ensure every bike receives semiannual maintenance, please contact us for any additional repairs, maintenance, or questions regarding your bike throughout the year and we'll be happy to assist.

From January through March of 2024, PikeRide+ participants rode their PikeRide+ ebikes for a total of **1,513 miles in 963 trips or 484 hours**, which is 20 continuous days. WHOA!

Having app issues?

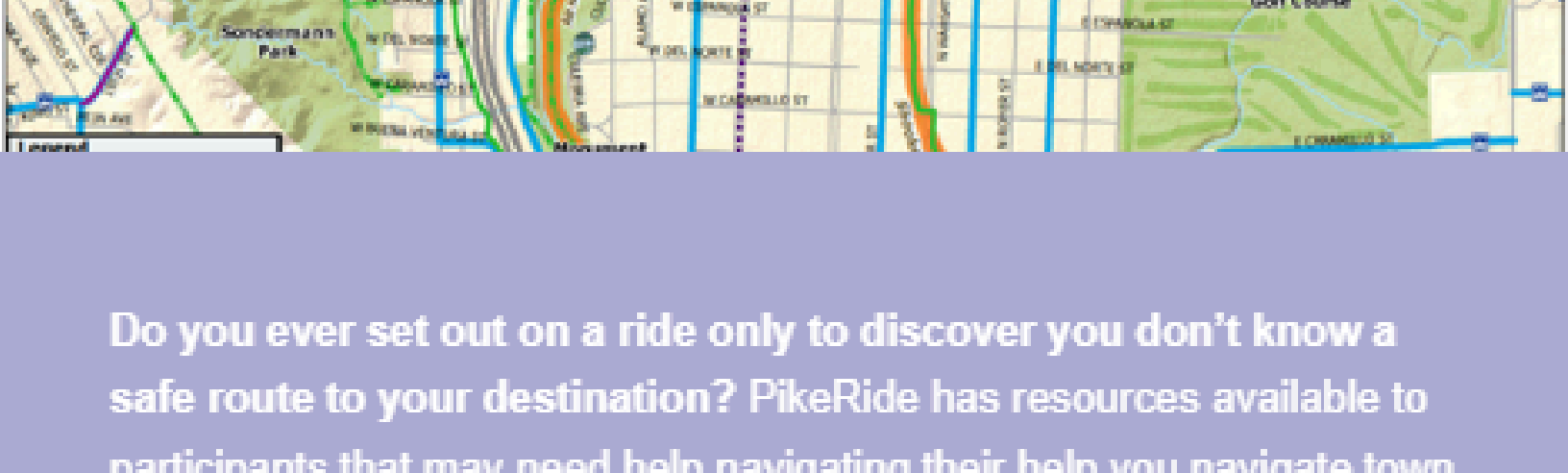
Make sure Wi-Fi is turned off if you're using the PikeRide app while out and about. If your phone is searching for a Wi-Fi signal it can prevent the app from operating correctly.

If you experience issues with the PikeRide app's map displaying your location incorrectly, check to make sure your Bluetooth is turned on and Wi-Fi is turned off which allows your ebike to communicate with the app properly.

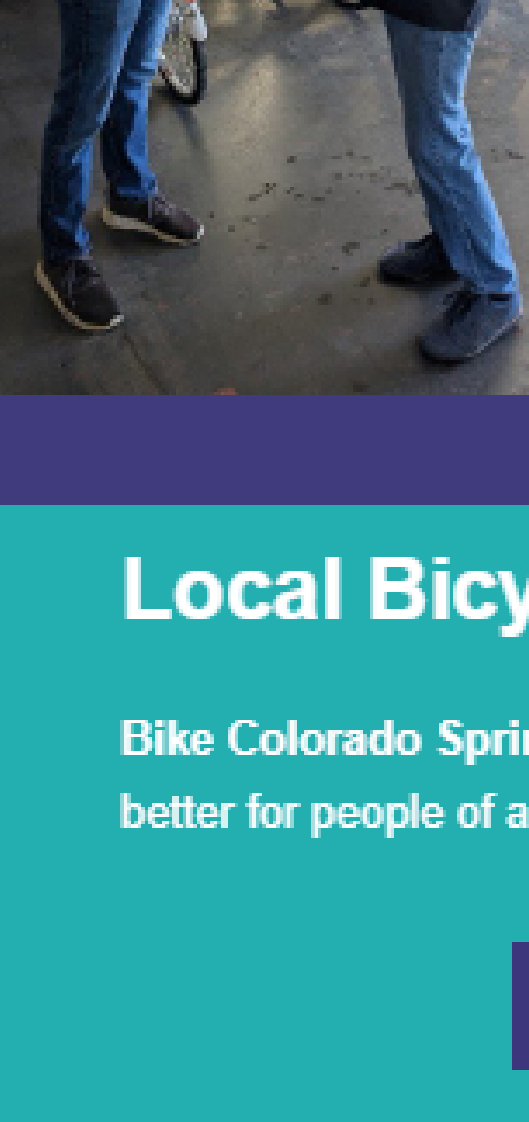
Where Do You Plan on Riding?
